“One Voice” was founded in September 1991 by its director, David F. Pressau, Minister of Music at Grace Anglican Church, Mount Washington. One Voice’s mission is to spread the word of God’s love through a ministry of music, illustrating that Jesus Christ came to this earth to pay a debt He did not owe, because we owe a debt we cannot pay.

“One Voice” is made up of people from many different walks of life and from many different denominations. Despite the differences in their backgrounds, all are united in their love for the Lord, and have been called to this musical mission field.

Toward the end of the program, the congregation will be invited to sing along with “One Voice.” The lyrics are included in the program.

Because this is considered a worship service, attendees are asked to withhold applause until the conclusion of the presentation.
